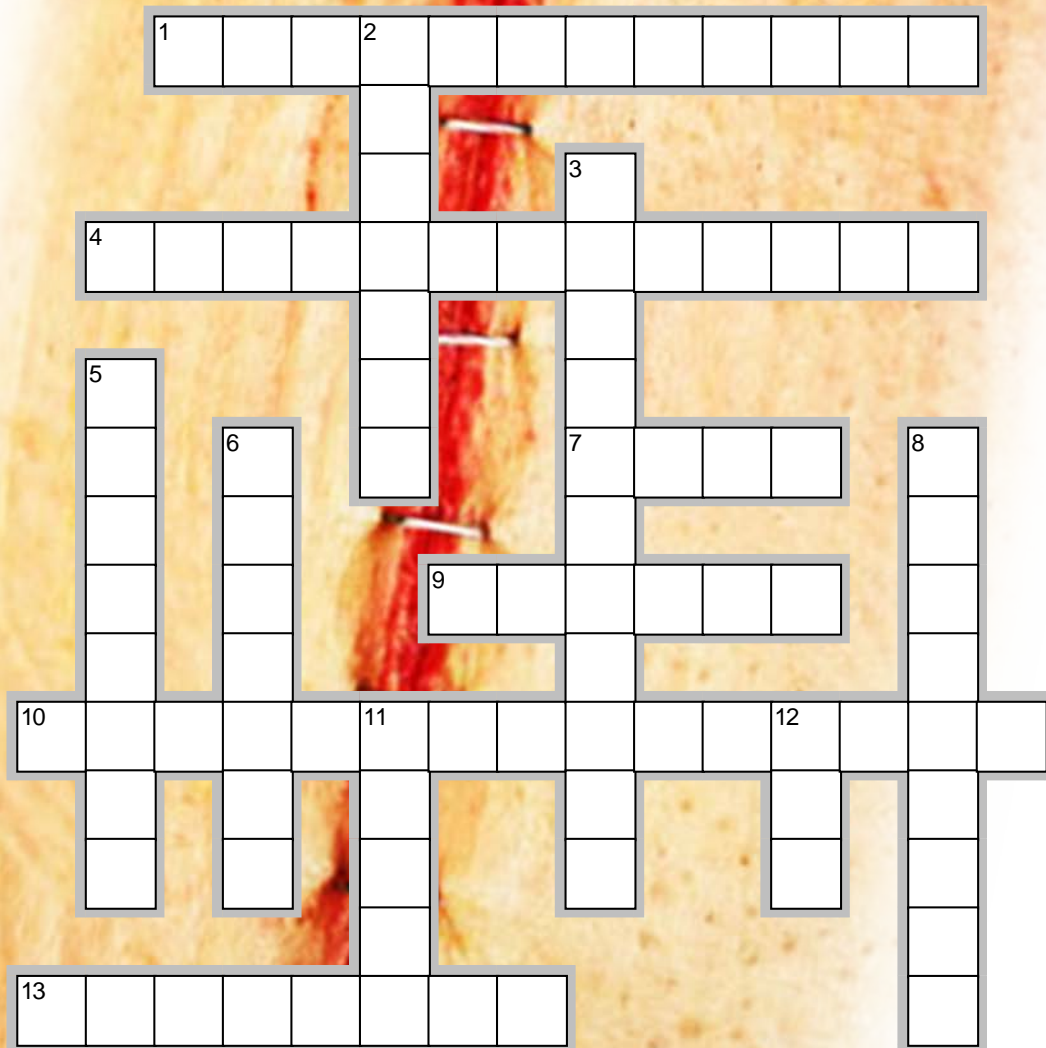




Skin Surgery Crossword Puzzle
