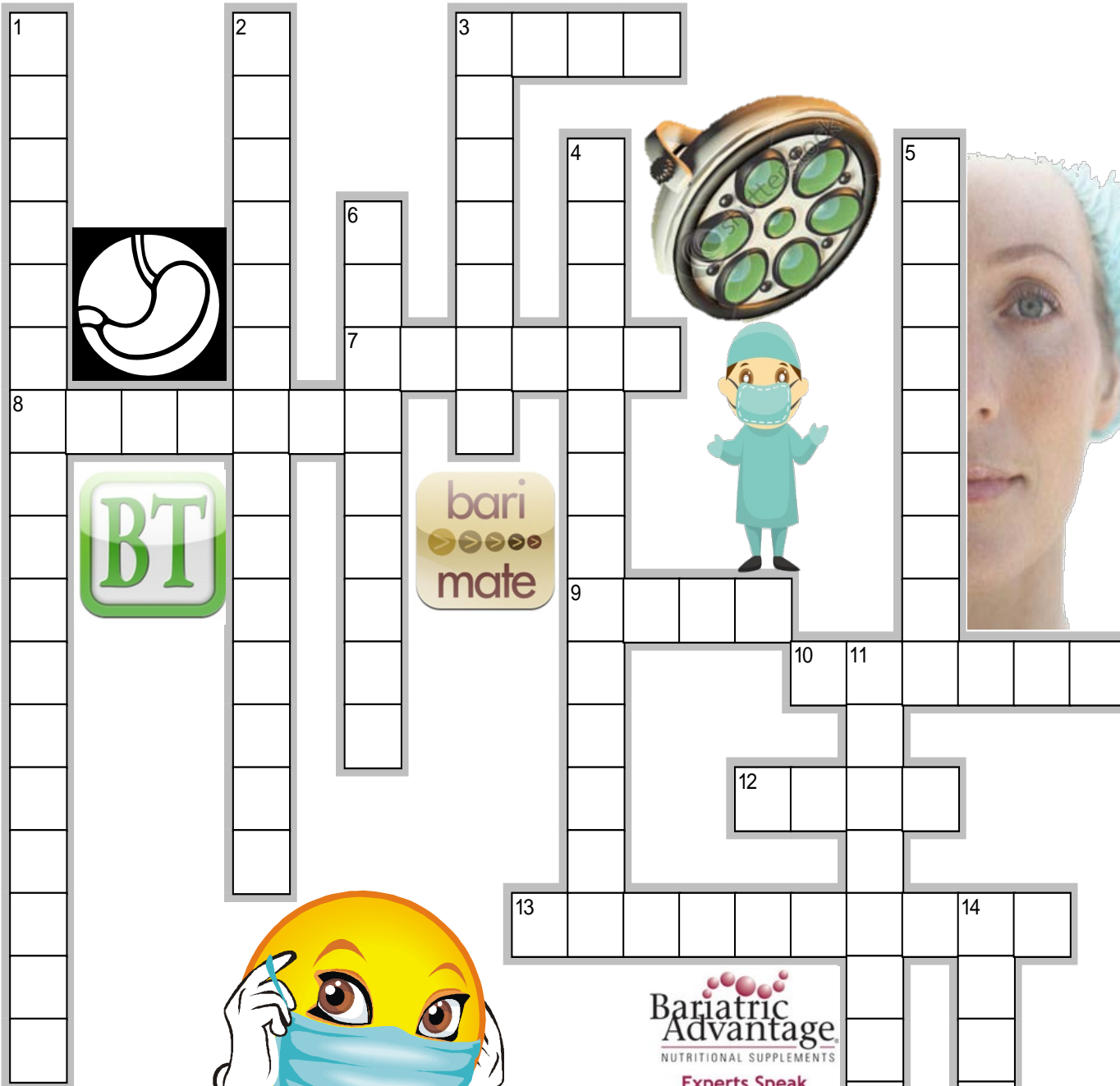




# Roux-en-Y Gastric Bypass Crossword Puzzle



## Across

- A gastric pouch is created with a \_\_\_\_\_ stapler.

- During a laparoscopic Roux-en-Y gastric bypass, the omentum is mobilized and the ligament of \_\_\_\_\_ is identified.
- Name of surgeon that first described part of this technique.
- The goal of bariatric surgery (two words; omit the space).

## Down

- This is created with either suturing or a circular EEA stapler.
- Malabsorptive procedures reduces the absorptive capacity of the \_\_\_\_\_ (two words; omit the space).
- Procedure performed laparoscopically that places a band around the top of the stomach (hyphenated word)
- The three categories of bariatric procedures are restrictive, \_\_\_\_\_ or a combination of both.
- \_\_\_\_\_ blue is used to check for leaks.
