


Cesarean Section Crossword Puzzle Key

- Most common type of anesthesia used for cesarean section.
- 6. Pharmaceutical used for hemorrhage.
- Pharmaceutical used following delivery of the uterus.
- Two words (do not include space) Premature separation of the placenta from the wall of the uterus.
- 12. Middle muscular layer of the uterus.
- Two words (do not include space) 4500g in a diabetic woman or greater than 5000 g in non-diabetic woman.
- 14. Uterine appendages (fallopian tubes and ovaries)
- 15. Who to call for cesarean section training.
- 16. Difficult labor and delivery caused by the size, shape or position of the fetus.
- 18. Abdominal incision.

- 1. Uterine incision.
- Common incision used in cesarean section.
- 3. Two words (do not include space)
 Disproportion between the size of the fetus and the pelvis, resulting in the inability of the head to fit through the pelvis.
- 4. Inflammation of the membranes that surround the fetus. It is usually associated with a bacterial infection, possibly bacteria ascending from the mother's genital tract into the uterus.
- 7. Type of incision used on the uterus that provides adequate access and low intraoperative blood loss.
- 9. Muscular organ.
- 11. The number of times a woman has been pregnant.
