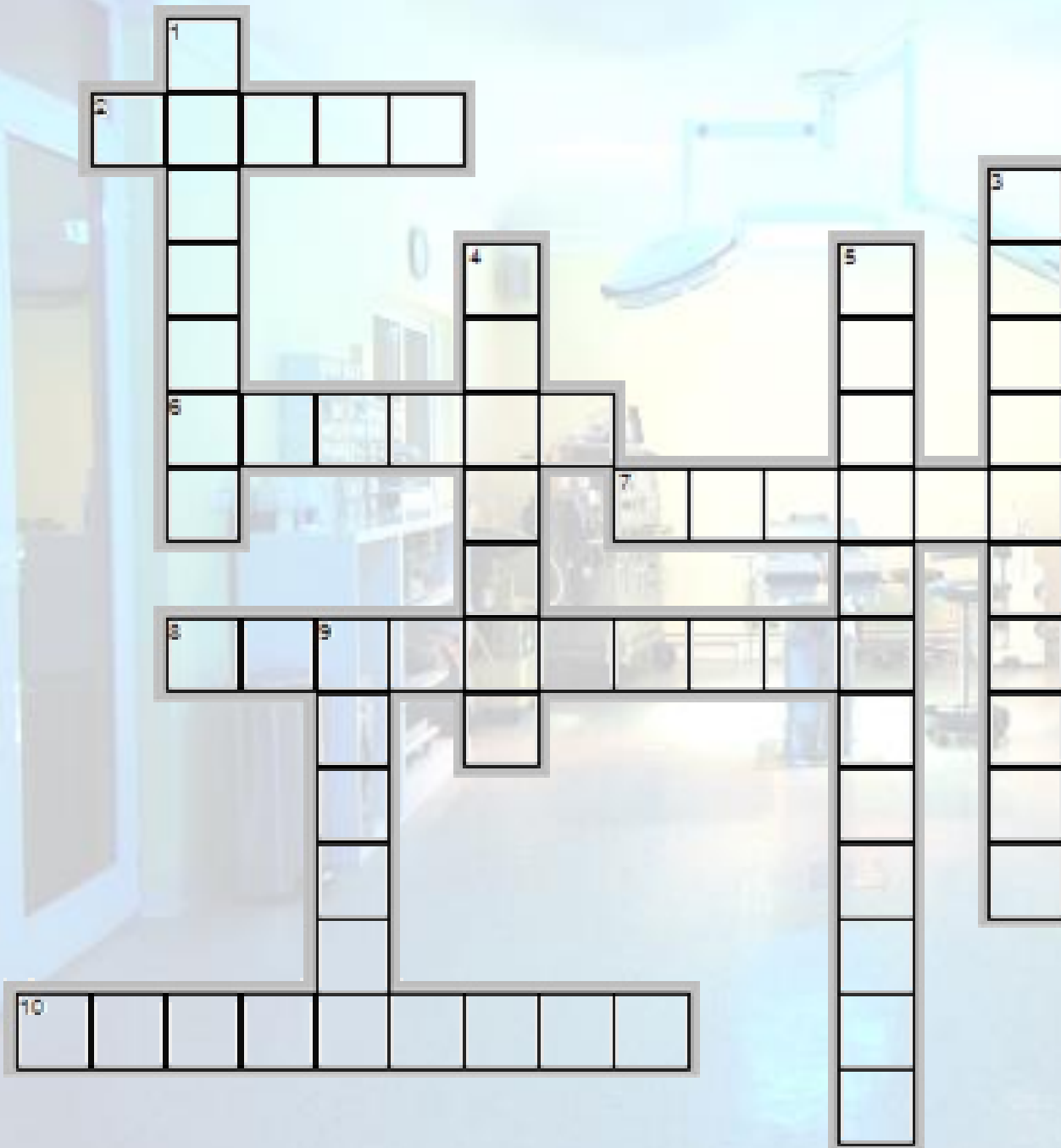




Mastectomy Crossword Puzzle
