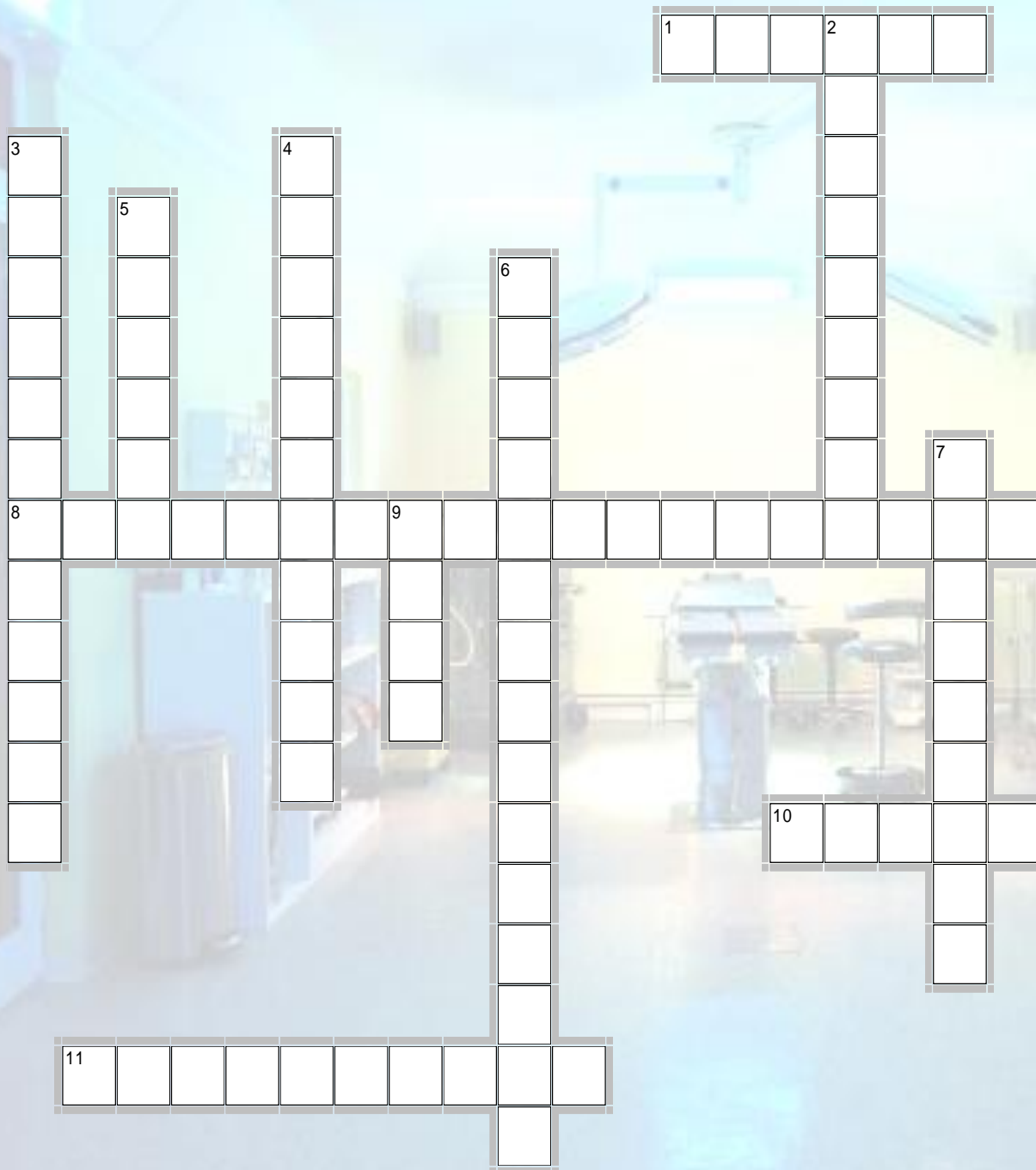




Cardiac Crossword Puzzle
